Todd has been training field bred spaniels since 1997. He participates in spaniel field trials and hunt tests in both the United States and Canada, has guided hunters for wild gamebirds, and is a professional dog trainer that firmly believes in the value of exposing hunting dogs to wild game-birds. "If a dog can produce the wild bird that the fox, coyote, weasel and hawk missed, then they would be of a caliber that any hunter would be proud to own."

Todd has won and placed in numerous spaniel field trials; including the 2018 National Open Championship and the 2017 National Open High Point Trophy. More importantly, he has developed numerous dogs and their owners that have won and placed in spaniel field trials; including the 2019 Canada Amateur Championship and they have passed spaniel hunt tests.

TRAINING PHILOSOPHY

Our training philosophy is based on several levels of training that leverage the dog's physiological/psychological make-up to get the results we need. **We are shaping behavior from the first day!**

At a very young age, we develop dogs that know how to go to work. We introduce the dog to birds and the gun. After this proper introduction, we begin collar conditioning and formal obedience in the yard and in the field. After adding patterning (proper use of the wind) and advanced training (steady-to-wing-and-shot), we end up with a finished dog that your friends will be honored to hunt over.

To have a finished dog, there are three primary phases of the dog's training:

1. Puppy shaping, games and boundaries
2. Formal obedience and expectations
3. Patterning and advanced training

Let us show you how **YOU** can work with your dog to create:

1. A bold and confident student
2. A dog that hunts in control
3. A dog that responds the first time
